

An overview of Option A IGCSE Sanskrit study
Grades C - G

Option A Language:

- Basic Sanskrit word order (e.g. verb comes at the end)
- writing the Sanskrit script in transliteration
- Noun/pronoun paradigms: *rāma, sītā, mitram, hari, guru* and *nadī*
tat in 3 genders
aham and *tvam*
- Verb paradigms: *bhavati* and *vardhate* in 3 tenses,
asti (present) and *āsīt* (past)
imperatives with the middle person, singular and plural, for verbs like *bhavati*

Ability to use the paradigm endings, where applicable, with other Option A vocabulary words.

- Past passive participles ending in *-ta* (e.g. *gata* ‘gone’); the use of a *-tvā* gerund (e.g. *gatvā* ‘having gone’), and its change to *-ya* after a prefix (e.g. *āgatya* ‘having come’)
- *iti* after direct speech
- *saha* with the third case ending (e.g. *rāmeṇa saha* ‘together with Rāma’)
- *samīpe* with the sixth case ending (e.g. *rāmasya samīpe* ‘near Rāma’)
- *dadāti* and *namati* with the fourth case ending (e.g. *rāmāya phalam dadāti* ‘He gives fruit to Rāma’)
- the use of the sixth case ending to show possession (e.g. *rāmasya pustakam asti* - ‘Rāma has a book’).
